ENVIRONMENTAL, TIMBER PURCHASING AND PROCESSING POLICY

Dover Trussed Roof Co Ltd is committed to protecting the environment through the implementation and maintenance of this Environmental and Timber Purchasing Policy.

The policy contains the following aims:

- To only purchase timber that has been harvested in compliance with the country of origin's laws and regulations.
- The company will not source any timber from:
 - Species prohibited under Appendix I and II of the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species (CITES).
 - Wood from genetically modified trees.
 - Uncertified high conservation value old growth forests.
 - The Company will comply with the European Timber Regulations (EUTR)
- The company is committed to PEFC ST 2002:2010 Appendix 2 Due Diligence System.
- The Company is committed to sourcing timber products from legal sources
- The Company will actively promote the use of timber which comes from sustainable sources.
- When purchasing timber to meet Chain-of-Custody requirements then the Company will only purchase from suppliers who are registered to recognised schemes such as FSC or PEFC.
- The company shall maintain registration to the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC) Chain-of-Custody scheme and shall ensure that the requirements of the scheme are fully implemented within the Company's management systems.
- The company will ensure information provided to interested parties relating to the source of timber supplied is accurate and not misleading.
- The company will ensure that appropriate training is given to all Employees associated with Timber Purchasing and Chain-of-Custody requirements.
- Timber wastage will be kept to a minimum during the cutting and manufacture of roof trusses and ancillary timbers. Wood waste is recycled wherever possible and any surplus is sent for composting rather than landfill.
- Recycling is promoted wherever possible, particularly metalwork, metal strapping, cardboard, paper and printer cartridges.
- Electricity consumption is reduced by using wood burning stoves fuelled by timber off-cuts from the manufacturing process, which in turn reduced the quantity of wood and paper waste to be sent for disposal.
- Timber Treatment is by a modern metal free water based micro-emulsion containing no Red Listed products. It is backed by the latest technology, carried out under strict procedures and has no volatile organic solvents to release to the atmosphere.
- The Environmental and Timber Purchasing and Processing Policy shall be reviewed by the Directors of the Company on an annual basis.
